POSHAN 2.0's strategic reorganization of existing scheme components aims to address prevailing gaps and accelerate progress in nutrition programs. Its primary verticals encompass nutrition support for various demographic groups, including children aged 6 months to 6 years, pregnant and lactating mothers, and adolescent girls in specific regions. Furthermore, it emphasizes early childhood care and education, spanning from infancy to early childhood years, and the enhancement of Anganwadi infrastructure, including the introduction of modernized facilities like Saksham Anganwadis. Dr. E. Ravikumar's participation as a speaker enriched the event, and appreciation was extended to all organizers for their pivotal role in ensuring its resounding success.

Beneficiaries: 142

The beneficiaries of POSHAN 2.0 are children aged 6 months to 6 years, pregnant and lactating mothers, and adolescent girls who have attended the session. The session gave insights on what type of food should be consumed and the benefit out of different foods which are essential for nutrition of the body.
